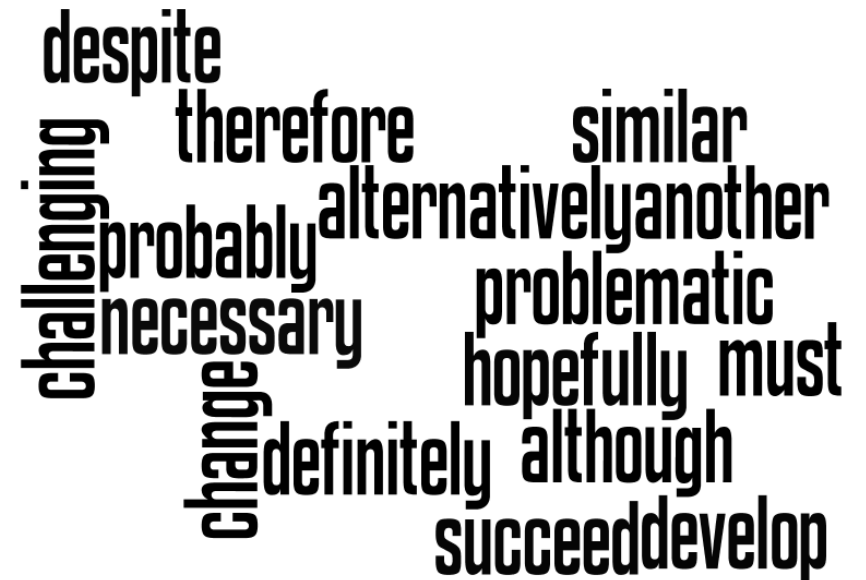


DESCRIBE: SENTENCES
